Acclimatization

At Montessori Casa International, every child has the right to a period of acclimatization. This period of discovering the new environment, accepting new people, other children and especially to be able to separate without pain from the family member who accompanies the child to school every day, can vary from child to child. All of us have our own pace and ways to accept a new place. This is important not only for the child but for the whole family who also goes through a change.\

This is why we begin very slowly in gradual steps. First the parent and the teacher get to know each other. They spend time together sharing the habits and the needs of the child. Then the child comes to school with the parent and spends an hour or so in the outdoor environment and in the classroom. The next day this period could get longer depending on the child. Gradually the parent steps outside the classroom but is still in the school and on hand to prevent the child from any anguish. It is only when the child is able to separate easily from the parent that the process of acclimatization is complete. It is fundamental that the child will always have the same educator who will take care of him/her.
